Helen Keller: American Socialist: This remarkable individual is rarely, if ever, associated with the suffragette movement. But her political stance in the early 20th century bears scrutiny. Besides her inspiring story of overcoming blindness and deafness to become a world-class lecturer and author, she was an ardent Socialist. She would campaign for Eugene Debs in his runs for the presidency. She was anti-Capitalist and pro-Worker. A member of not only the Socialist Party but the more radical International Workers of the World or Wobblies. She was anti-War and, a foe of Woodrow Wilson and America's entry into the global conflict in 1917.
